Term of Service: 3 years, renewable

Accountable To: CROSO Board President and CROSO Executive Director

CROSO's **Mission**: CROSO is dedicated to making possible the transformation of Ugandan

Expectations:

1. Participate in all 4 annual CROSO board meetings.

- a. Board meetings are held in the Chicago area and members are expected to participate in person or via phone.
- b. We understand that emergencies happen and important family functions (weddings, etc.) get scheduled without checking everyone's calendars.
- c. However, if more than one meeting is missed in a calendar year, that board member will be removed from the board for the following year.
- 2. Actively participate on at least one committee.
 - a. Participate in at least 75% of those meetings either in person or via phone.
 - b. If the board member cannot be present for the committee meeting, a conversation with the chair of that committee will need to be scheduled for it to count as participation.
- 3. Act as an ambassador for CROSO in the community.
 - a. Share with others that you are involved in this work. (This can include friends, family, colleagues, announcements to your alumni chapters, etc.)
 - b. When opportunities arise, help network on behalf of CROSO.
- 4. Contribute new names to our email and mailing lists.
- 5. Fill at least one table at the annual benefit each year.
 - a. This obligation can be met through the board member purchasing the table and inviting guests for free or getting nine individuals to purchase their own seats at your table.
 - b. If it is not possible for the board member to fill a table, then he/she must be a member of the annual benefit event committee.
